# THE SECOND SCRIPTURE LESSON: 1 Timothy 1: 12-17 Pg 1350 Gratitude for Mercy

<sup>12</sup> I am grateful to Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because he considered me faithful and appointed me to his service, <sup>13</sup> even though I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and a man of violence. - Involved in purposeful action and activities through the structure of self-directed Mission Teams.


